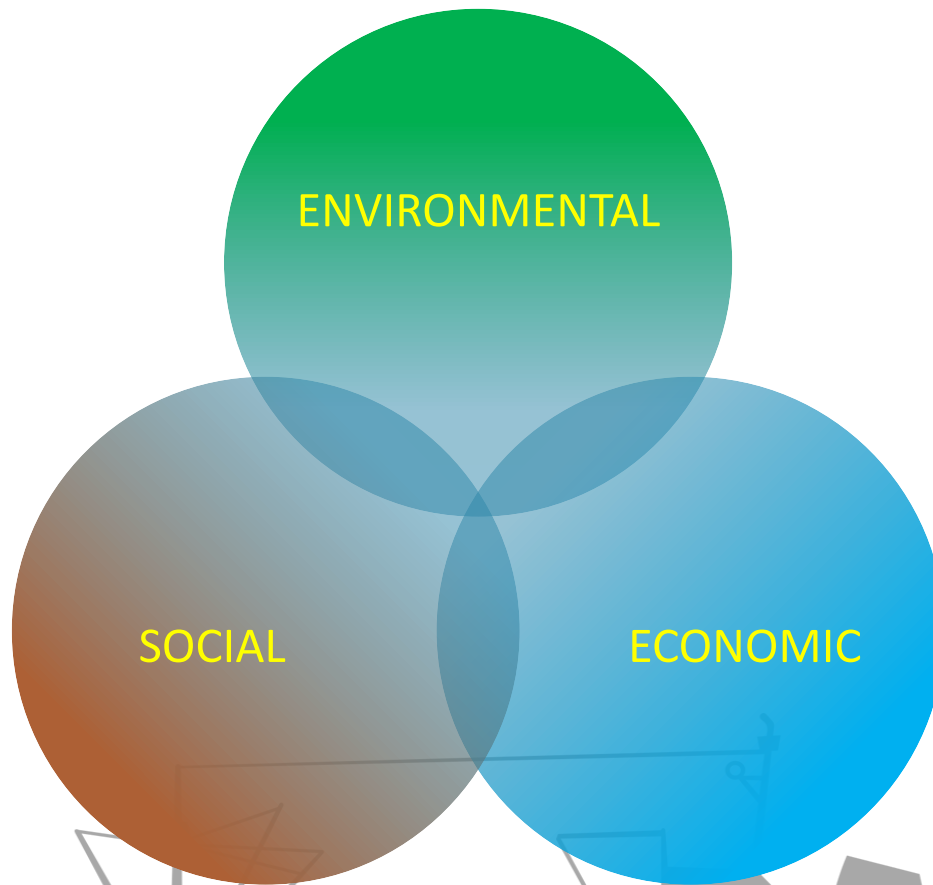

Safety & Environmental Protection

- Safety standards for ships, crew and operations
- Additional measures

Shipping & Climate Change

- Significant CO2 emission reductions
- Increased fuel efficiency in the future



Limits To “Real” Emission Reduction

- Dependence on fossil fuel
- Need to match global goals

Economic Measures



- New design, technology or fuel possibly a solution
- Market based measure probably inevitable
